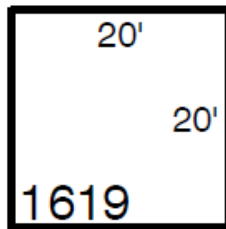
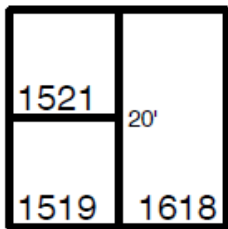
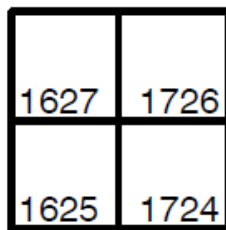
• Exhibitors & Exhibit Hall •
