Post-Baccalaureate Genomics Analyst Fellowship: Applications for the 2026-2028 fellowship are open through February 1, 2026.

The Post-Baccalaureate Genomics Analyst Fellowship program is for recent undergraduates to gain exposure to and training in multiple career paths that advance public service for human genetics and genomics. Training will focus on services for the public benefit, especially those provided by governmental and nonprofit organizations.
